Preventing Slips, Trips, and Falls

- Keep walkways and workspaces clear. Put away all tools, parts, etc. away properly.
- Close open drawers, cabinet doors, machinery access panels, etc. when not in use.
- Clean spills immediately.
- Never jump from a piece of equipment or platform. Maintain 3 points of contact when mounting or dismounting machinery.
- Remove snow, mud, dirt, etc. from machinery steps as it accumulates.
- Inspect ladders before use. NEVER use a cracked, bent, or broken ladder. Follow proper setup and use procedures.
- SLOW DOWN. Slips, trips, and falls often occur while in a hurry.
- Watch your step...literally. Pay attention to where you are walking! Avoid carrying items in a way that blocks your vision.
- Consider wearing slip resistant footwear when working in areas that tend to be slick.
- Use adequate lighting to illuminate the areas where you are walking and working.
- Never run up or down stairs. Avoid skipping stairs. Use the handrail, whenever possible.
